

## PRIMARY SECTION

## SCHOOL UPDATES

#### **House Meetings & Student Council Election**

The election for the Student Council was held at N. L. Dalmia High School on 30th March 2023. The objective of appointing the Student Council is to provide a platform to the students to develop leadership qualities by organizing and carrying out school activities and service projects. In addition to planning events that contribute to the school spirit and community welfare, the Student Council is the voice of the student body. They help share students ideas, interests and concerns with the school wide community. The students from all the houses filed their nomination for various positions. #### First Aid Training by Junior Red Cross Society

On the 1st and 15th of April 2023, the Maharashtra state branch of the Red Cross Society organized a first-aid training session. Infused with zeal and enthusiasm, the grades VI to X students exhibited immense curiosity and eagerness towards the event. In an enrapturing and interactive 3 hours training session, pupils were apprised of everyday accidents and their first aid requirements. The session commenced with bright, cheerful faces and a crisp introduction about the event by Ms. Priti Thackrey, followed by Mr. Bhavesh's brief speech. Next, the baton was passed to Dr. Swati Kale, who proved to be excellent guide throughout the session. Upon absorbing comprehensive instructions provided by Dr. Kale, students were guided into bandaging techniques, which they meticulously tried on their peers.

Information was disseminated regarding tackling burns depending on their degree of severity. In addition, volunteers from the audience came forth to assist in demonstrating numerous techniques. The competent authorities also highlighted first aid for fractures and dislocations of bones. The students were also acquainted to adopt first aid procedures during a medical emergency in the school. Engaging and spellbinding videos were displayed in tandem with the hi-tech presentation. Knowledge regarding snake bites, bee stings, poisoning, bleeding, and electric shocks was also shared with the inquisitive minds.
